2017 CSC Pleasure Show Rules

1. The Show Committee makes the final decision on any changes or disputes that occur during the shows.

2. Membership applications and fees must be paid in advance to receive member discounts at shows.

3. If a dispute occurs over a class or placing, the protest must be brought to the attention of a member of the show committee, show secretary or show steward.

4. Under no circumstances is an exhibitor or spectator allowed to approach a judge for any reason without a Show Committee member or show steward present.

5. The judge and show committee have the right to excuse all horses or riders which present a threat or danger to other horses, riders and spectators from the class or show grounds and all entry fees will be forfeited.

6. Good sportsmanship is expected. No abusive language, actions or cruelty to any horse or person will be tolerated at any time, inside or outside of the show rings.

7. Riders must wear proper riding attire. No tank tops, halter tops or swimsuits. Boots or riding shoes with heels are required.

8. Wearing helmets will not be penalized in ANY classes.

9. All Showmanship Classes may be shown in either English or Western Attire.

10. All tack changes should be announced to the show committee at least two classes prior to the start of the class.

11. All classes have a gate call. After your class has been announced, you have one minute to enter the show ring.

12. Please leave the gate areas clear for exhibitors to enter and exit the show rings.

13. All entries are assigned one number for each horse/rider combination. If signed up for Year-End Awards, that number shall be used for the entire year at all CSC series shows to receive points.

14. Youth under the age of 18 as of the current year may not handle/exhibit a stallion.

15. There is a \$50.00 returned check fee. Anyone previously giving a bad check for entries will be on a cash only policy for the rest of the show season.

16. Anyone paying by check and not paying in full at the time of sign up must leave a signed open check at the secretary stand.

17. All accounts must be paid in full by the end of each show.

18. In case of injury, CRC has the right to call for medical assistance.

19. All dogs must be on a leash, tied to an object or person with a leash no longer than 6 feet and kept away from show rings. Please leave aggressive dogs at home.

20. All children under the age 17 must be accompanied by an adult.

21. Chambersburg Saddle Club, its officers and members will not be responsible for accident, injury or loss of person, livestock or property.

22. By entering a class, you confirm that you agree/understand these rules.

HORSE SHOW CLASSES:

1. Lead Line = 10 & under who can safety sit on a horse/pony, may also show in the Limited Division.

2. Limited = Age Specific. No cross entries into loping or cantering classes NO EXCEPTIONS. Designed for true novice and new to showing riders.

4. OPEN = Any age rider.

5. Youth = 18 & under as of January 1 of the current year

- 6. Warm-Up Classes = May use 2 hands and training gear.
- 10. Scratches = must be made at least two classes in advance
- 11. Adds = added classes may be made at any time before the class starts.
- 13. CSC Stakes All Day Pleasure = Open to any CRC member. \$125 Payback guaranteed as follows: $1^{st}-$ \$45, 2^{nd} - \$30, 3^{rd} - \$20, 4^{th} - \$15, 5^{th} - \$10, 6^{th} - \$5

YEAR END AWARDS

1. Must be a CSC member in good standing.

2. SIGN UP! If you are interested in being considered for the Year-End Awards must sign up at the secretary stand prior to the start of the show. Points will not be counted until we receive your sign-up sheet – NO EXCEPTIONS. There is a \$10 fee per nomination per division to help fund exceptional prizes for the Year End Awards.

3. Points are based on a HORSE/RIDER combination. A horse substitution will void all points and start new at the show in which a new form is submitted (additional nom. fee not required).

4. Exhibitors must participate in at least 3 of the 4 shows. (Exception if a show is cancelled and not rescheduled)

5. Points will be calculated on a set scale. 1st =8, 2nd =7, 3rd =6, 4th =5, 5th =4, 6th =3. Participation in class = 1 point.

6. Year End Award participants will be assigned a show number and that number MUST be used throughout the show season to receive points. Please remember your numbers!

Halter classes will not count towards year end awards
